ROSÉ

Rosé wines, sometimes referred to as 'blush' wines, represent a spectrum of colours from the palest salmon to the deepest pink. They are made in one of two ways: from a blend of red- and white-wine grape varieties; or from red-wine grapes only, which are allowed brief skin contact (for six to 24 hours) to attain the desired level of colour. In South Africa, rosé wines are also made from Pinotage, a local cross between Pinot Noir and Cinsaut. The product shall have the colour that is distinctive of a rosé wine.

PINOTAGE

Pinotage is South Africa's signature red wine grape. Pinotage is a one-of-a-kind rustic red wine that is earthy, fruit-driven, and perfect for pairing with barbecue. Medium Bodied. Typical Flavours: Red Juicy Fruits, Strawberries, Raspberries, Red Cherries, Banana, Toffee, Fig Jam, Rooibos Tea.

SHIRAZ

Syrah, also known as Shiraz, is a popular red wine. Syrah is typically bold and full-bodied, with aromatic notes of smoke, black fruit and pepper spice. It can be round and fruity, or dense and tannic with a usually high usage of oak aging. Full Bodied. Typical Flavours: Blueberry, Black Cherry, Plum, Pepper / Spice, Leather Saddle, Meaty, Tobacco, Chocolate, Cinnamon, Vanilla, Liquorice.

MERLOT

In the regional French dialect of Bordeaux, the name merlot means "little blackbird" (after the blackbirds—spelled "merlau"—who reportedly love to eat the grapes). Merlot's aromas and flavors include Blackberry, Cassis, Baked Cherries, Plums, Licorice, Dark Chocolate, and Mocha.

BORDEAUX LEFT BANK BLENDS STYLE

Red Bordeaux Blends are powerful structure and deep flavors. Dark fruits and berries such as plum and blackcurrant are commonly used to describe the flavors of red Bordeaux, although there is an unlimited range of terms that have been ascribed to them. Tannins tend to be relatively high in these wines, giving them a firm structure, and perfect for red meats that are flavouful.

DESSERT
